Inside, the decor is stunning.






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
And the artwork adorning the common rooms is exquisite.

The suites and guest rooms are fully-appointed, and continue the theme of aristocratic comfort.



















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Of further interest is the roof top and the wellness centre. And for guests on longer stays, there is the possibility of staying in adjacent apartments.
