

It is a simple and humble restaurant, the kitchen staff all native Turks – and they put their heart into every dish, delivering delicacies left, right, front, and center!


The menu, in fact, is extensive, and much more developed than one might expect.

From soup...



And check out those Turkish herbs and spices! This lentil soup tastes completely different from those regularly served in Dubai!

... to baked flatbread "pide" of all sorts of toppings varieties.







You can see the quality of the effort from the kitchen in both the handmade construction of the pastry, as well as the lightness of the dough utilized – a top quality pide!



But Pide Keyfi doesn't stop there!

Their little kitchen races like a turbo-charged V8 engine, and live-fire charcoal grills the meats, a gas stove top keeps the sauces warm, and the firey doner spins like a top – and the results are fantastic!
