Isolated in the captivating nature of South Iceland, Hotel Rangá is a luxury log-cabin retreat and a dream location for the northern lights and stargazing.







With the option for a northern lights wake-up call, this once-in-a-lifetime opportunity is a reason on its own to experience Hotel Rangá!



The glass-encased restaurant provides traditional Nordic meals, granting an opportunity for natural and locally available ingredients – below is a memorable reindeer dish.





Plus, motorized outdoor activities are available, too:




But it is the breath-taking nature that steals the show!
