As Al Maeda is caressed by the sea breeze, it is fitting that they offer a great selection of seafood, prepared in a variety of ways.







But not only, and the accompaniments and grilled meats were excellent, too.





And I implore you not to miss a taste of their desserts, especially the clotted cream, called *ashta*!
