to open spaces for viewing pleasure and reflection,







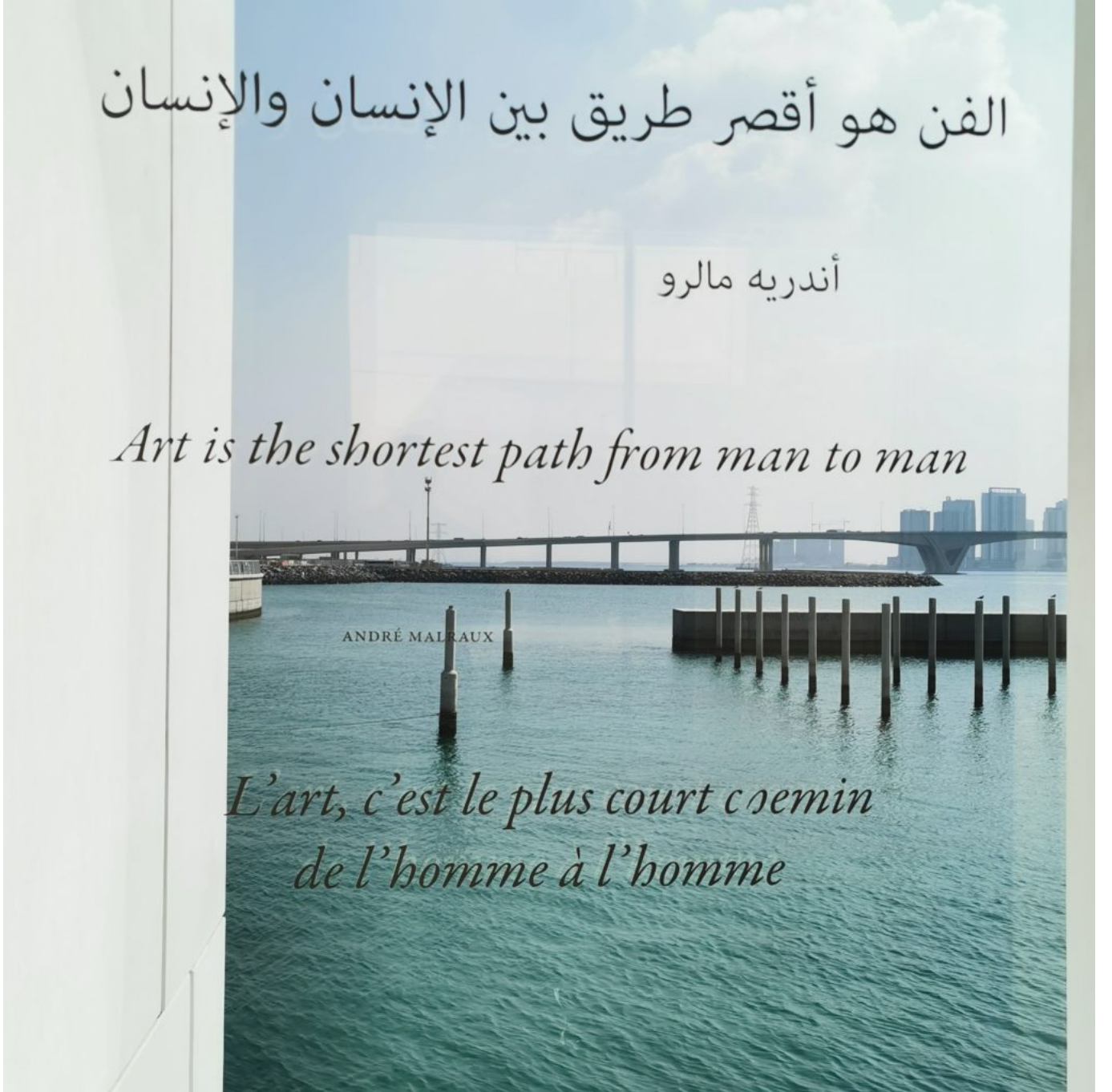


as well as chances to get up real close to examine the work intimately.





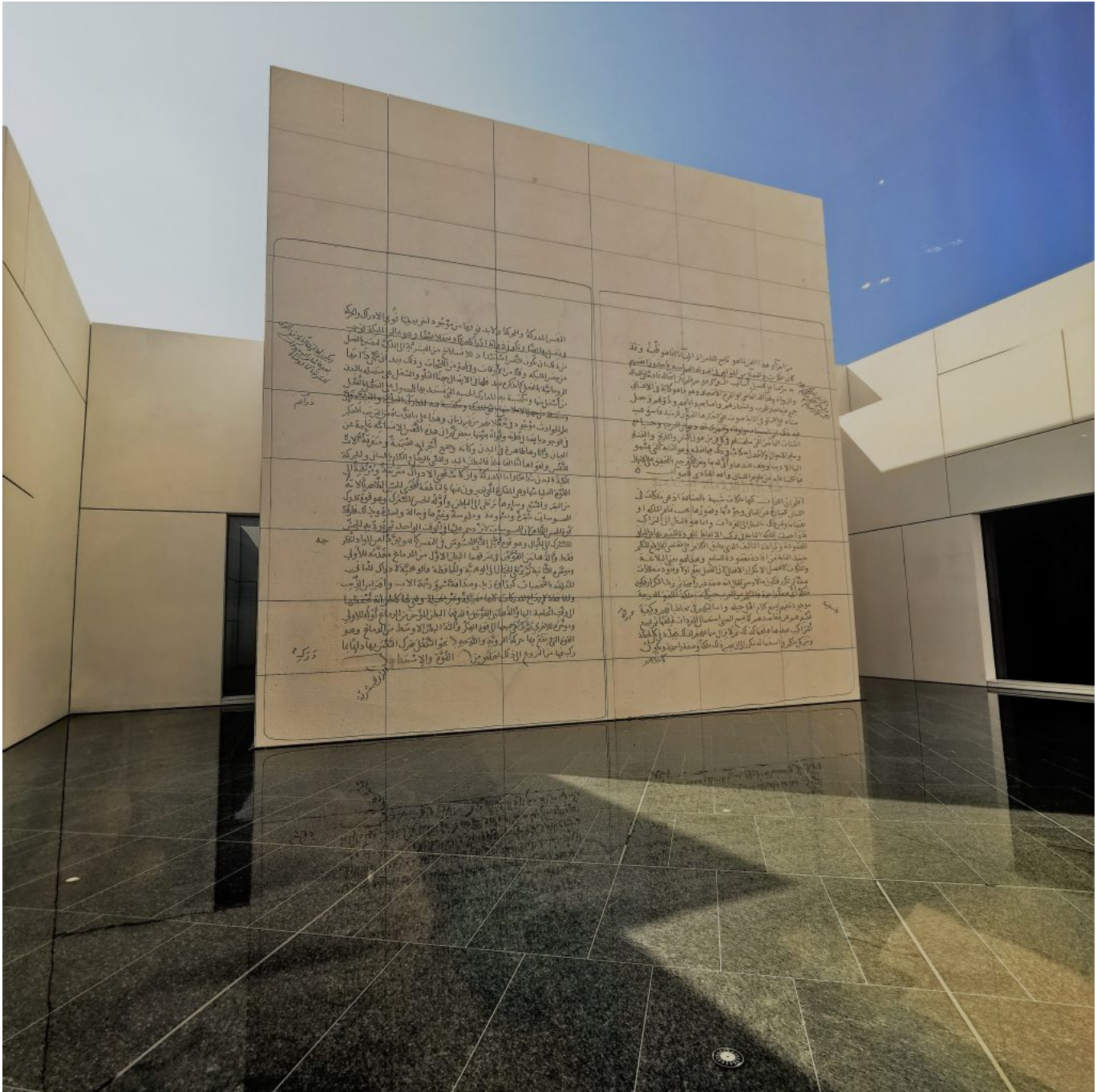
Along the way are magical nooks and crannies, and views to the outside through windows such as these below...



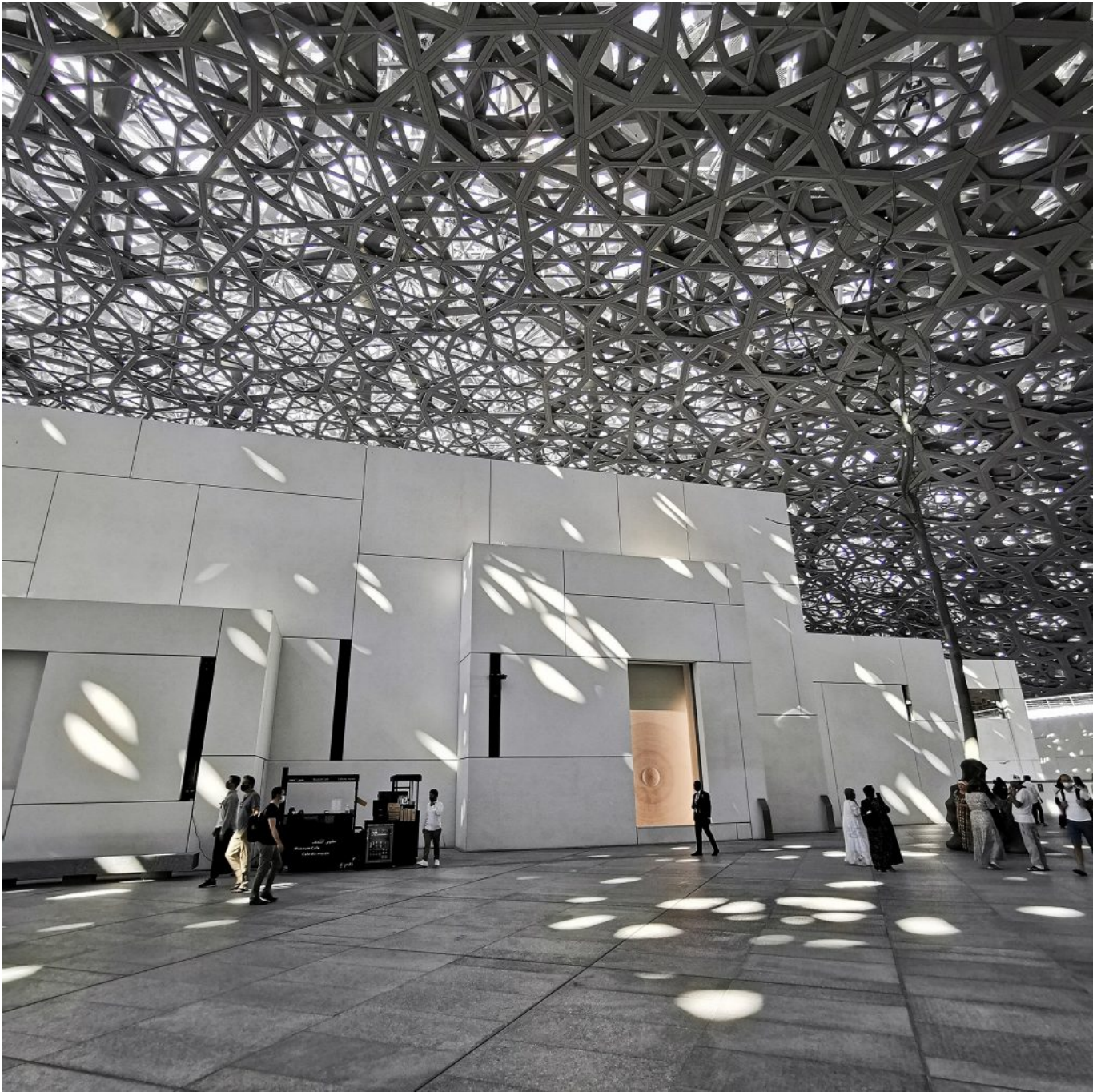




Until you reach the exterior halls, a natural part of the museum experience at the Louvre Abu Dhabi.







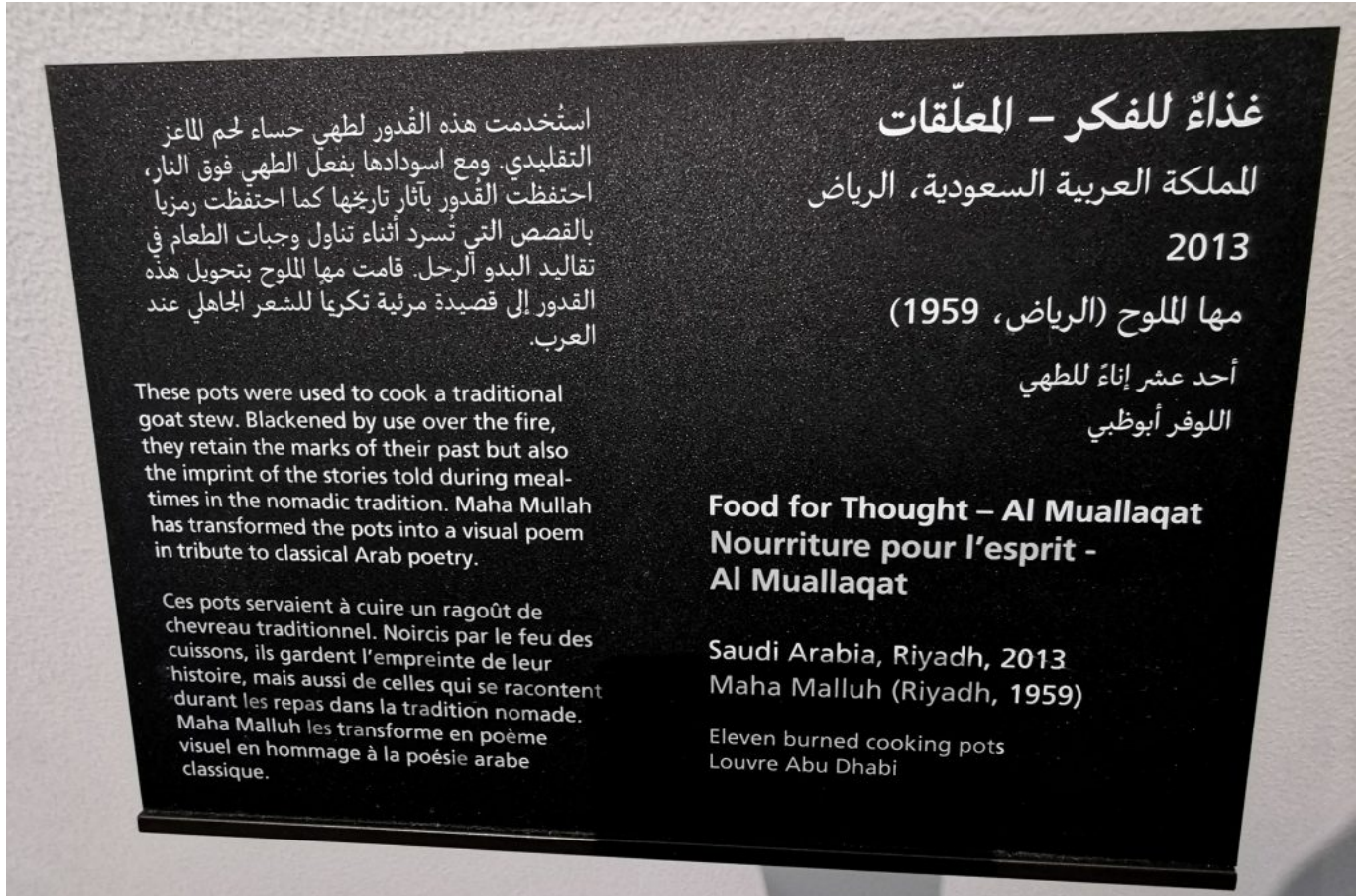
