Y bar gets it, and they have invested expertise behind the counter - where it counts.



In fact, a bar must be professional – even the center of a hotel, not a token appendix, tucked away behind the stairs.







...where the thinkers would meet over the years, and discuss the affairs of the world, over drinks and coffee and cigars.





Selection of fresh draft and bottled beer, of course – but also be available to cater to whatever whim and desire on the spur of the moment. Tickle my fancy.



Great quality grilled veal bratwurst, and again just top-choice, top-notch ingredients, preparation, and presentation – it was super delicious!


