


Electric Pawn Shop remains an enigma.


Doesn't look too comfy, yeah?




I loved it!




Basically, duck off - I play the music, you listen. Dance if you like.




I ask for a cocktail - can you choose me a colorful one?

I almost hate to admit it, my colorful request dropped cold, but it was exceptional!







Along the same irreverent ethos, Electric Pawn Shop describes itself as an Asian Mediterranean – huh!? – bar restaurant inspired by the '70s Chinatown of New York.

Whatever that means.

But there's no doubt that the Electric Pawn Shop bar restaurant of 2022's Dubaitown in UAE has a special energy – you can feel it.

I'm not into Feng Shui, nor mystical readings of Zen buildings, but Electric Pawn Shop is actually... electric.

I promise you.

I don't understand how or why, but the atmosphere has a raw energy feel to it – captivating, mysterious, swirling around you, pulling your hair playfully... and the menu is off the charts in both uniqueness, and as you taste the dishes, mesmerizing flavors!

For instance, here is the Island Satay Chicken Bomb, with tempura chicken – except, of course, that satay is skewered and grilled over coals... and has nothing to do with deep-fried tempura. In the mundane world, at least.




And so Electric Pawn Shop elbowed its way into my fancy.
