I feel Dubai sometimes needs this reminder.








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If you've been there, I'm pretty sure you're now nodding your head in agreement; and if you've not eaten there yet, you're in for a treat!


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The ingredients are chosen with care, and prepared in-house, especially for you.

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Either iced or brewed hot, at your table...






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Vietnamese coffee is unique, and toasted to a rich dark aroma that is unmistakable when properly brewed.
