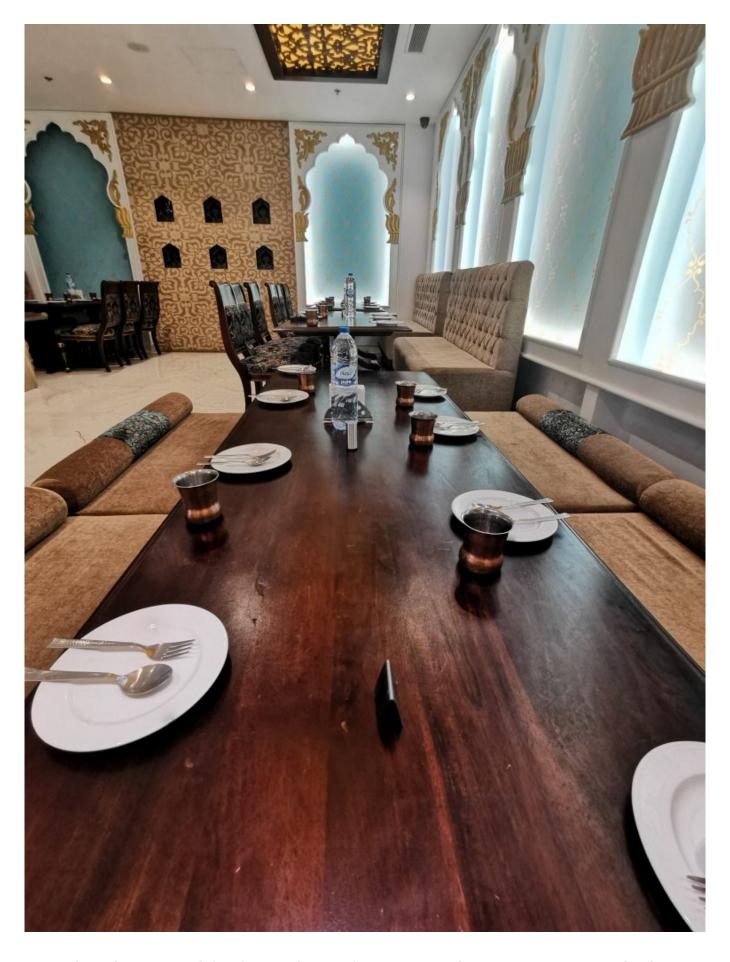


Empty your weekend calendar, as a fantastic Indian vegetarian meal awaits you at Delhi Highway Restaurant in Dubai!

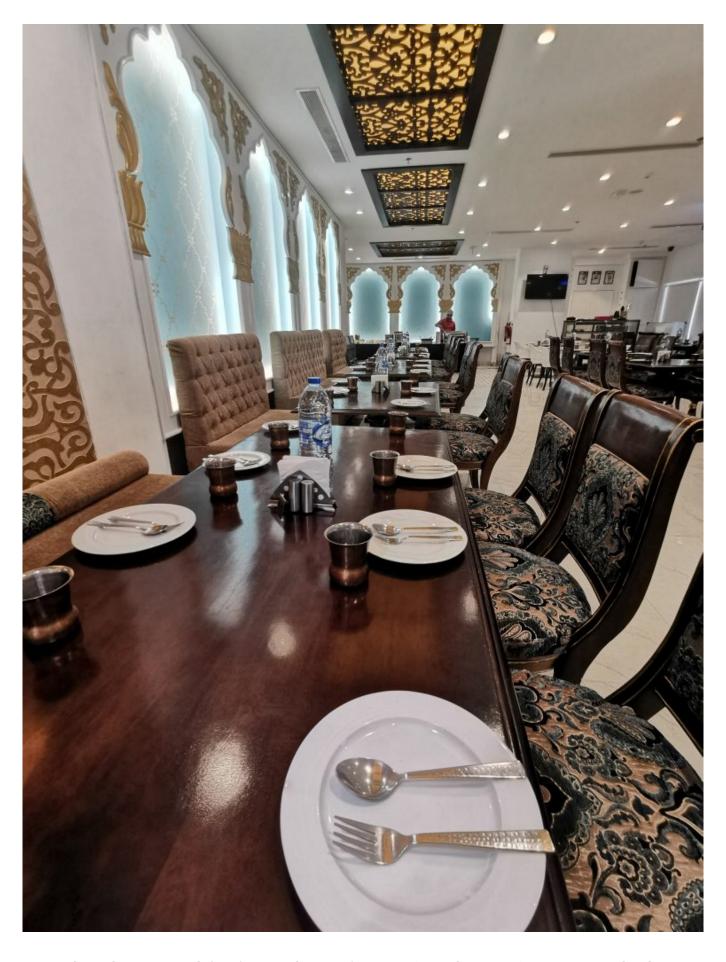

"Who is more delicious? Is it me?" asks the Bao Bhaji...



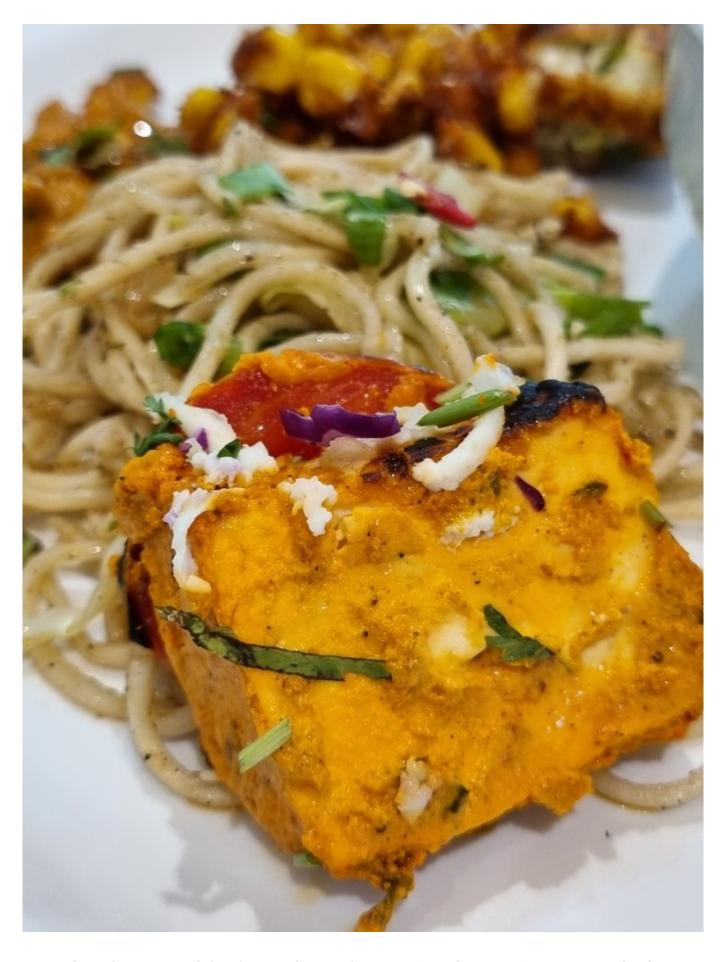


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"Wait! Try me! Am I the best..?" exclaims the grilled paneer!





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"Try me! Look at how fresh I am!" suggests the Kachi Keri, a green mango-based drink...



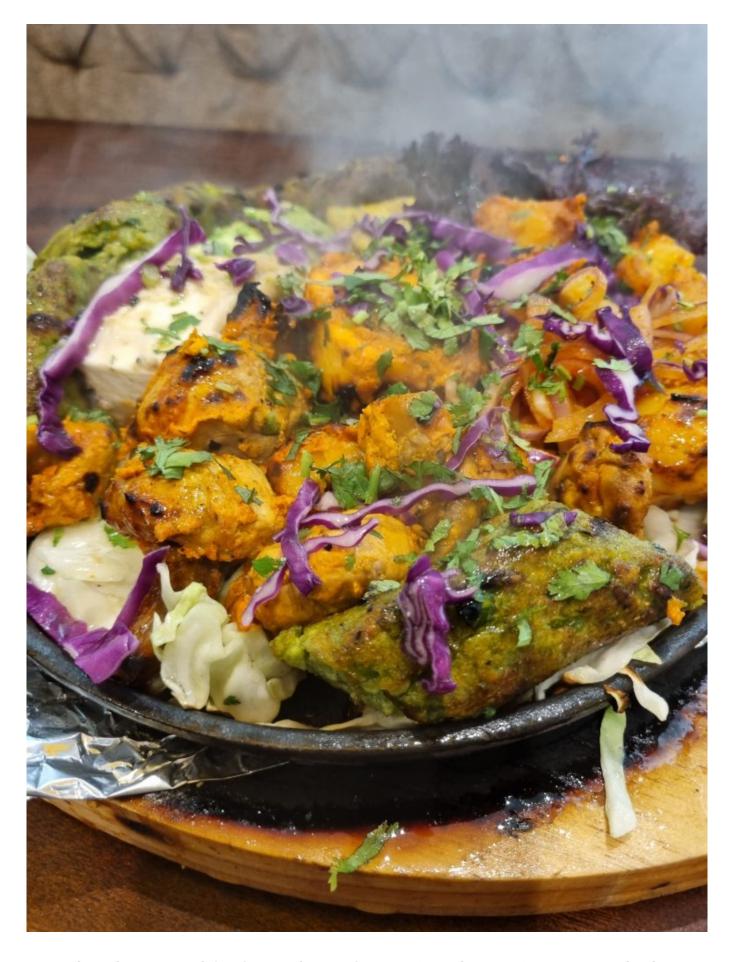


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And so goes the weekend meal at Delhi Highway, in a crescendo of deliciousness second to none.





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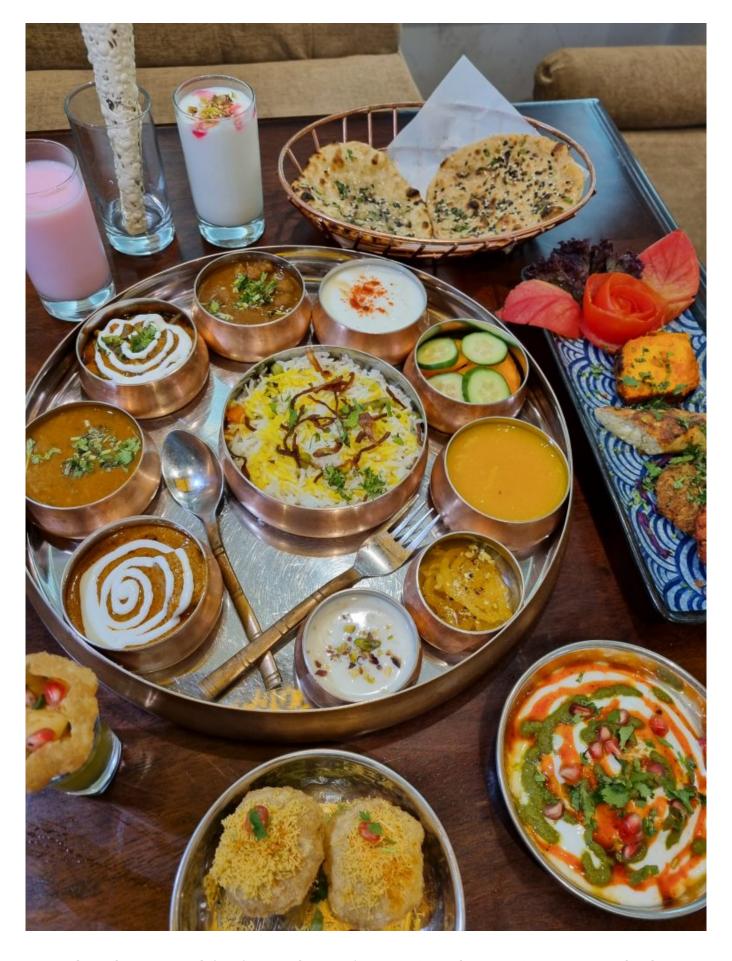


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Until the majestic *Thali* pulls rank: "I am the boss around here!"
